Ran HOWCO temperature survey, same showed top cement at approximately 875' off bottom. U.L.C. minimum of 90 hrs. Baled hole dry for shut-off test. No additional fluid. Satisfactory shut-off. Intend pull all 10" and manually fill annulus outside 8" with cement all way to cellar.
