You will please comply with the above requests as well as execute proper transfer of the well in question relinquishment signed by you and acceptance signed by Mr. Gruemmer and we shall be happy to release your plugging bond. As the Gruemmer bond is a blanket bond it does not specify any particular well but your one-well bond does. Therefore it behooves you to cooperate in the formality of executing the aforementioned transfer.
