
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A complete report on work done and results obtained shall be forthcoming and may be filed on our Form C-103. Needless to say the proposed cementing job on the Gruemmer well is incomplete as no mention of amount of cement to be used is included. Nonetheless enough cement shall be needed so as to fill the annulus from the bottom of the casing to the shallowest important water zone, as listed in Form C-105 at 333'. This is to prevent intercommunication between the different water zones exposed to the well bore. I refer you to Rule 107, (a), in our Rules and Regulations.

Please find enclosed your approved copies of Form C-102 on the two wells, with exceptions annotated.
