Last week this office contacted Mr. Dale Knot with Penteco in Oklahoma. This office was informed that operations have ceased on the above referenced location and the well has a total depth of 1650 feet. The Oil Conservation Division has yet to receive any of the required forms and was not notified when the surface casing was set. Under no circumstances will this rig be moved off location until production casing is set or the well plugged and abandoned according to our rules and regulations. This office will require plugging or casing be set no later than July 15, 1986.
