Mr. Pearl Dennisson has, as you know, been given the job of plugging the Ringle Wells on the Tome Land Grant in Valencia County. Mr. Dennisson's operations are somewhat limited by the available equipment which he has to work wells over and plug wells. It is our belief that he has made, and is making, a conscientious effort to plug the Tome wells as soon as possible.

At the present time there are several farmers in South Santa Fe County who are having water trouble due to the high winds which have blown over their windmills. Mr. Dennisson firmly believes that he will be able to accommodate these farmers and still be able to plug the Tome wells by June 1st if we grant him an additional extension of time. We have, therefore, extended the time until June 1st as you will note from the enclosed letter.
