Dear Mr. Corey:

My clients from the Tome Grant, were in this morning. At my request, they checked and nothing has been done towards the plugging of the wells on the Grant.

Would you have Mr. Ringle contact Mr. Frank D. Baca at Tome. He can easily locate him at his home or through Paul Torres, who has a grocery store on the Tome-Belen road. We would like to have Mr. Ringle proceed to have the wells which requires plugging, so done, in accordance with the requirements of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission. Also as to what ever property he has which remains on the Grant, We want to be assured that he will either remove the same, or sign a Relinquishment to the Board. We do not want to have another action for damages to property belonging to Mr. Ringle, which are on the Tome Grant lands, and which we have repeatedly requested that he remove.

If he does not want this junk, the Board will clear the area and dump all the remaining junk into an arroyo where it may be covered up. They want to clear these premissis.

When Mr. Ringle has given evidence that he intends to comply with this request, and is doing so, I will advise my clients to pay him the \$200.00 judgment owe him.

The Oil Conservation Commission informs us that Mr. Ringle has agreed to properly plug these wells. We request that it be done promptly.
