Reference is made to the Hingle No. 1 and Hingle No. 3 Wells located in the NE/4 NN/4 of Section 34, Township 6 North, Range 4 East, NMPM, Valencia County, New Maxico, which the Commission, by letter dated February 25, ordered to be plugged within thirty (30) days of that date.

Please be informed that the undersigned, as the owner and the operator of Dennisson Contractors has negotiated an agreement with Mr. Cecil S. Ringle to pull the casing in the above-described wellholes and to plug the wells.

We have made a physical inspection of the well sites and found that due to moisture and weather conditions it would be extremely impracticable to move a rig onto the locations at this time.
