Dear Mr. Ringle:

I have your letter of May 27, 1947, also your Notice of Intention to Drill Well #3. We have a Notice of Intention to Drill approved February 8, 1946, in Section 34, Township 6N, Range 4E, Valencia County. According to the C-101, this is 990' south of the north line and 1650' east of the west line of the NW 1/4. If you have drilled a well at this location we do not have any record of its being done. All we have is the C-101. This would be Well #1.

You have a Notice of Intention to Drill also in Section 34, Township 6N, Range 4E, being 330' south of the north line and 1980' east of the west line of the NW 1/4. If you have drilled a well in this #1 location we can not approve the drilling of the #3 Well until you have posted another bond or until you have plugged and abandoned the original #1 Well and changed your bond to this location.

We also have in our files a Form C-101, that is called #3 Well which is in Section 35, Township 6N, Range 4E. This location was approved March 31, 1947. You have a well you call #2 Well which I have a record of as being drilled 990' south of the north line and 1650' west of the east line of section 35, Township 6N, Range 4E. This well has a Form C-102, Notice of Intention to Plug Back for Water Well. I do not have Form C-103 stating that you have plugged back and made a water well out of this well.

This shows that you have application for four wells to be drilled. Two in Section 34 and two in Section 35. Will you please give me correct information as to what has been done in regard to old locations.

I cannot approve the Form C-101 until the information has been received as to the drilling of the other wells. I hope this will be clear to you.
