A driller's total depth of 6079.7' had been reached on May 6. Schlumberger checked bottom at 6091' on May 7 and also took a number of side wall cores at all significant electric log formation peaks. The contracted depth for the above listed operator was 6,000'. Mr. Long has a five day period to decide whether to plug & abandon at this depth or turn the well over to Sunol Oil Company for deepening. In the latter eventuality the well would be temporarily abandoned pending Sunol's assuming responsibility to deepen.
