INSPECTION REPORT

On April 16, I inspected the above captioned well. Drilling was resumed on April 12, when the cement plug was drilled out at the base of the 208' of 10 5/8" casing that had previously been cemented. Total depth at the time of inspection was 1658', reached with 9 5/8" OSC-1 and OWS bits. The driller's log to T.D. is as follows:

170-222'	Cement and gravel
222-390'	Pea gravel
390-576'	Sand & pea gravel
576-1047'	Sand & gravel with streaks of lava
1047-1378'	Sand & shale with streaks of lava
1378-1621'	Sand with lime streaks
1621-1658'	Sand & lime

The well was shut down for repairs at the time of my visit.
