Dear Sir:

The most recent information which we have on the above captioned well is a formation log to a total depth of 8495' as prepared and submitted by Mr. Jess Carruthers, your geologist at the time of your last drilling activity. We were not notified of your shutting down the well and I only found this out after visiting the well and talking with the watchman there.

I assume that you have shut down in order to use the drill pipe in some other venture in another state. Please submit to this office a notice of your intentions with your reasons for so acting, (on Oil Conservation Commission Form C-102), for our approval. Similarly we would like to know how much time you desire to carry the well as temporarily abandoned and what your plans are for its eventual completion, be it dry or productive.

You must realize our concern in this well and the fact that we try to encourage all out-of-state operators. However, for the sake of the record, we need to carry a play-by-play account throughout a well's history and your laxity in this respect is highly irregular.

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
