Dear Dudley:

I have at hand your note of June 18, wherein you ask that you be notified in the event Sunol Oil Company resumes work on their San Clemente No. 1.

I have just this minute received a Notice of Intention to Drill dated June II, for Sunol No. 1, located 280 feet North of the South line and 280 feet West of the East, Section 32, 7-N-1E. Mr. D. L. Wade, General Manager states that they will make a \$25,000 Bond. As you know, we only require a \$5,000 plugging bond, but I suppose we could have no objection if he makes it \$25,000. But as yet we have not received the bond. He further states that the first productive oil or gas sand should occur at the depth of 4171'.

Will drop you a note when we have received the bond and everything is ready for their operations.
