Note: Because the release was strictly natural gas, there is no associated remediation activity and the Division simply opens and closes the C-141 remediation permit. However, the closure sheet within the C-141 packet (page 6) is still required for these events. Thus far I have been creating one to use that only contains my signature, but I would ask that in the future for natural gas releases that closure page be included. Additionally, the Division would like to see some form of calculation or estimation of how the release volume was calculated.
