Triple R Two Inc. (TRT) Mr. Ray Reid-President & General Manager, 1927 Talbott
Guymon, OK 73942, 580-338-4505, is applying for an Oil Conservation Division Surface
Waste Management Permit pursuant to OCD Rule 19.15.36 NMAC.

The facility will be re-cycling spent produced water in order for reuse in oilfield
operations as approved by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division. This facility is a
state-of-the-art system, which will clean produced water so it may be reused in lieu of
using valuable fresh water.

The site is proposed to be located in the SE/4 NW/4 of Section 26-Township 20S-Range
32E approximately 31 miles west of Hobbs New Mexico, Lea County, adjacent to the R-
360 disposal operations off of highway US 62-180, commonly called the Half-Way
area.

The System will be a series of tanks and trailers mounted on top of a synthetic liner
and bermed for protection of the environment. There is no beneficial shallow
groundwater under the site, records do indicate limited possible high total dissolved
solids water at a depth of 300 ft. or greater. The quality of this water is unknown, but
suspected to be non-potable as it lies in a historic general region where fresh water
aquifers have never been found or utilized.

Pursuant to applicable parts of the Oil Conservation Commission regulations 19.15.36 NMAC, the Oil Conservation Division (OCD) has completed its technical review of TRT Inc. application dated June 16, 2014 for a waste management facility for the treatment of produced water at the location described below. OCD has tentatively decided on permit approval with conditions.

Triple R Two Inc. (TRT) Mr. Ray Reid-President & General Manager, 1927 Talbott Guymon, OK 73942, 580-338-4505, is applying for an Oil Conservation Division Surface Waste Management Permit pursuant to OCD Rule 19.15.36 NMAC.

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The System will be a series of tanks and trailers mounted on top of a synthetic liner and bermed for protection of the environment. There is no beneficial shallow groundwater under the site, records do indicate limited possible high total dissolved solids water at a depth of 300 ft. or greater. The quality of this water is unknown, but suspected to be non-potable as it lies in a historic general region where fresh water aquifers have never been found or utilized.

The following alternatives, exceptions or waivers pursuant to the rules were obtained and approved by OCD. Exception to the requirement under 19.15.36.8(C)(5) NMAC for certification by a registered professional engineer as there are no features associated with the proposed facility needing such certification. Regarding laboratory samples and information regarding groundwater. The proposed facility will incorporate a liner under its entirety.

A person, whether or not such person has previously submitted comments, may file comments or request a hearing on the application by filing their comments or, in accordance with 19.15.4.9 NMAC, a hearing request with the division clerk within 30 days after the date that the applicant issued public notice of the division's tentative decision. A request for a hearing shall be in writing and shall state specifically the reasons why a hearing should be held. The division shall schedule a public hearing on the application if, in addition to the requirements in 19.15.4.9 NMAC:

(1) the division has proposed to deny the application or grant it subject to conditions not expressly required by rule, and the applicant requests a hearing; (2) the director determines that there is significant public interest in the application; (3) the director determines that comments have raised objections that have probable technical merit; or (4) determination of the application requires that the division make a finding, pursuant to Paragraph (3) of Subsection F of 19.15.2.7 NMAC, whether a water source has a present or reasonably foreseeable beneficial use that contamination would impair.

If the division schedules a hearing on an application, the hearing shall be conducted according to 19.15.14.1206 through 19.15.14.1215 NMAC.
