Initial groundwater sample analytical results at the above referenced well site from the production tank spill indicates contamination to be above the State of New Mexico Water Quality Control Commission's regulatory standards for benzene and total xylenes. The sample was collected from a monitor well (MW #4) installed by Envirotech, Inc. on April 26, 2000. Sampling of the monitor well was conducted April 27, 2000. Depth to water is estimated at approximately 40 feet below ground surface. Listed below are summary analytical results for benzene, toluene, ethylbenzene, and total xylenes (BTEX):
