
Reference is made to your application dated August 27, 1996, for an 80-acre non-standard gas spacing and proration unit consisting of the following acreage in the Eumont Gas Pool:

LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO  
TOWNSHIP 20 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, NMPM  
Section 18: S/2 NE/4

It is my understanding that this unit is to be dedicated to the existing Mexico Well No. 3 (API No. 30-025-06165), located at a standard gas well location 1980 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the East line (Unit H) of said Section 18.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of **Rule 2(a)4** of the "*General Rules for the Prorated Gas Pools of New Mexico/Special Rules and Regulations for the Eumont Gas Pool*", as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, Texaco Exploration and Production, Inc. is hereby authorized to operate the above-described non-standard gas spacing and proration unit, with allowable assigned thereto in accordance with Rule 5 of said special pool rules based upon the unit size of 80 acres.
