Reference is made to your application for approval of a 160-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Eumont Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

Township 20 South, Range 37 East, NMPM N/2 S/2 of Section 29

It is understood that this unit is to be ascribed to your Amos B. Reeves Well No. 1, located 1980' from the south line and 660' from the west line of Section 29, Township 20 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

Inasmuch as you enclosed waivers from the offset operators agreeing to the formation of the proposed unit, it is possible for immediate approval to be granted.
