The OCD has denied the submitted Remediation Plan C-141 for incident nRM1930943618 (1RP-5778) for the following reasons:

- The horizontal extent of the release has not been delineated. Please keep in mind Closure
 Criteria for Soil Impacted by a Release include GRO+DRO as a constituent with the limit of
 1000 mg/kg. Though the rule allows to keep soil in place with 1000 mg/kg GRO+DRO and
 2500 mg/kg TPH, the horizonal boundaries/background samples of the release should show
 soil to contain no more than 100 mg/kg TPH.
- The Remediation Plan pages were not included with this submittal.
