

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*: Reference IRP-4372 Free liquids were removed from the spill area. Contract company excavated visibly saturated soil to a depth of 16 feet vertical. The impacted area was evaluated for depth and quantity of chlorides. A Remediation Closure report was submitted on December 18, 2012 and scanned into the NMOCD system on 7-29-16. The actions taken are included in that report.
