The 2" nipple was compromised breaking off of the man way on an oil tank, the tank was not in production at the time of release. This caused an estimated 58 bbl oil loss and 7bbl of water of which 65 bbls were recovered and placed back into the tank. This facility is in a Falcon lined containment.
