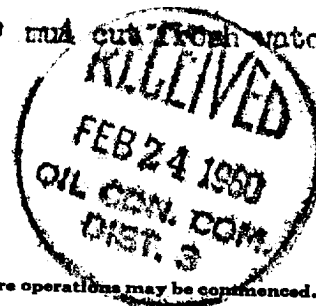

Chlorides on water 310 p.p.m., no show of oil or gas.
