in the top of the cement and should extend four
feet above the surface of the terrain.

Mr. James E. Kapteina, District Engineer for the
Oil Conservation Commission, Santa Fe, New Mexico, will
witness the plugging of these wells and must be notified at
least 48 hours before commencement of operations.

The Commission has given the defendant herein
ample opportunity to plug these wells or to see to it that
the principals plug them. While our sympathies are with
the surety company in a case of this nature, nevertheless
in the interest of conservation the wells must be plugged,
even if the surety finds it distasteful to do so. For
these reasons we earnestly request your cooperation in
having these wells plugged as soon as possible. This
office will be glad to cooperate in any way.
