Dear Mr. Buttram:

By letter of April 3, 1959, this office requested that you report all work done on the subject well plus your plan for further operation of this well. Also, we called your attention to that portion of the Commissions Rules and Regulations which states, "When drilling operations have been suspended for 60 days, the well shall be plugged and abandoned unless a permit for temporary abandonment shall be obtained from the Commission". Since you have chosen to disregard this letter we now have no choice but to direct you to proceed immediately with plans for the proper plugging and abandonment of this well. Your plugging program must be filed with this office on form C-102 prior to actual plugging of the well. Further, form C-103 showing all strings of casing run, and all cement used and form C-105 "well log" must also be submitted at that time. These forms shall be filed with the Commission in Santa Fe no later than August 7, 1959. We are sending you a supply of these forms with an instruction sheet with this letter.
