I found it necessary to discontinue use of the rig on the LaRoe location so released it then ran a Schlumber log to determine just where we were and what would be necessary to finish the well. I am pleased that our deductions were supported by the log even though our conclusions were somewhat in conflict with those of the major engineers who have been very kind with their suggestion although admittedly lost.

I have the well well protected and am arranging for a standard rig to move on location and drill the remaining footage which will be in total depth between 13 - 1400'. The rig should be on location within 15 days.

I shall submit a copy of the log to your office but trust that it will not be made available to others some of whom offered to pay for the log for a copy of it but I feel that it will be to my interest to keep the hole rather tight. I sincerely believe that we shall have an excellent well and so do the major engineers. Apparently we must be running 300' high or with this
