Dear sir :-

Not having a reply to my letter of november 4th advising that we wanted to cement our well about november 8th, having our driller and men on the job we went ahead and cemented today.

We set the 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " casing at 1499 $\frac{1}{2}$ ' in good firm formation, we filled the hole back up from bottom of 1516' to 1504' with rock and put in about 35# of lead wool on top and killed the gas dead, had the casing swung on the spider at 1499 $\frac{1}{2}$ ' we put in 15 sacks of cement which brought the cement up in the casing about 80', we then picked up the casing about 12' and let it back down and swung it and set on clamps solid at 1499 $\frac{1}{2}$ ' pumped in water under pressure to force the cement up outside of the casing at bottom and let it stand for the present.

We expect to drill the cement out in about ten days and put on the valve and complete the job.

Will you please send us the forms to fill out and we want your representative to inspect the well when completed.
