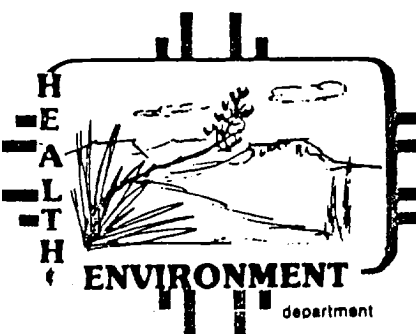

Re: Drilling rig complaint of 6-20-83

Dear Mr. Vlvog:

This letter is to reiterate our conversation of 6-21-83 on a complaint called in on 6-20-83 of a potentially poor drilling operation taking place north of the old mining town of Dawson within Colfax County.

Aspects of this complaint are as follows:

- A- Individual complaining would not give his name- claimed he was a "freind" of the State of New Mexico, and was very much concerned over the shoddy practices taking place at the above drilling site.
- B- He claimed mud pits were badly seeping out into the Vermejo River- potential water pollution hazard.
- C- He also claimed that a terrible dump site exists consisting of discarded chemical containers, trash and other debris. This may be potentially serious hazardous and solid waste violations.

The above complaint may warrant further investigation by the Oil Conservation Division.
