Our notice of intention to drill the St. Louis Rocky Mountain Well No. 2 indicated that we would set a 10 3/4" OD surface string. We now propose to run a surface string of 13 3/8" OD Armco spiral weld casing. If prudent drilling practice so dictates, a 9 5/8" OD, 36#, intermediate casing string will be set and cemented.
