Attached is a copy of Oil Conservation Commission Order R-5019. Your consideration of this order as it applies to your Vaughn State Well No. 1 (E-16-6N-17P) is requested.

This well was plugged more than two years ago but the location was not cleaned or leveled. According to the last correspondence submitted (letter of 1/20/75) your plans were to "re-drill." This can be interpreted as an intent to re-enter the well. Consequently, the project is in the "Temporary Abandoned" classification and cannot be ignored. Because the 7/23/75 request for information from this office has not received a reply, we are scheduling the matter for hearing on July 21, 1976. A copy of the docket will be mailed to your and to the bond company prior to that date.

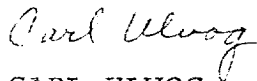

Gentlemen:

Your Vaughn State Well No. 1, located in Unit E, Section 16, Township 6 North, Range 17 East, NMPM, Guadalupe County, was plugged 6/15/74; according to your report (Form C-103) submitted 6/24/74. On September 30, 1974, the location had not been cleared or levelled and your attention was directed to this matter by letter from the undersigned on January 13, 1975. Subsequently, by letter dated January 20th, you requested permission to delay cleanup operations because of plans to conduct additional exploration in the immediate area. The stated time for such exploration is "this spring or early summer."

Please advise if those plans have materialized or if additional delay in cleaning the Vaughn State location is desired for other reasons.
