On this date I inspected the above captioned well, which was spudded on April 9, and obtained the following information. The total depth was 347' and 13 3/8" surface casing was cemented today at 344' with 150 sacks of cement. Drilling will be resumed at noon on April 14th.

The rig is a jackknife rotary with deisel power. A Petro-Graph Engineers mud logging unit will be employed to log the column drilled from surface casing to final depth.
