INSPECTION REPORT

On this day I visited the above captioned well which was drilling satisfactorily at 4085' at 10:00 a.m. OSC bits are being used at this depth and the drilling rate is approximately six feet per hour. Since my previous report, core No. 2 was cut at 3788'-3798' and resulted in recovery of six feet of dark brown to wine fractured shale with no show of oil or gas.

Cuttings samples of the interval 3570'-4080' were delivered to the Commission. Missing were samples representing the interval 3430'-3570', which were erroneously sent to the Amarillo office of the operator.

In this report I stated the above mentioned well which was drilled
approximately to 1000' at 11:00 a.m. The first 100 feet was
this depth and the drilling was in approximately six feet per
hour. Since my previous report, some 40' was cut at 3750'-3755'
and resulted in recovery of oil in fact to level of about 3750'
depth with no show of oil or gas.

Further analysis of the interval 3750'-3755' was delivered to the
Laboratory. Analysis was made and determined the interval 3750'-
3755' which was approximately 100' in the thickness of the
formation.
