1. Skidded rig from Well No. 2 (Abandoned due to parted surface casing). Spudded 8-3-56. Drilled 12-1/4 inch hole to 465 feet, reamed to 17-1/2 inch diameter to 330 feet.
2. Set 13-3/8 inch 54.5#, J-55, 8R Thd., ST&C casing at 330 feet. Cemented with 450 sacks common cement. Cement circulated to surface.
3. Nipped up. Tested casing and BOP to 900 PSI for 30 minutes 8-7-56. Held o. k.
4. Drilled cement plug, resumed drilling formation with 12-1/4 inch bit.
