Enclosed herewith is Form C-101, Application to Drill the subject well. Also enclosed is Form C-103, Report of Beginning Drilling Operations, and Form C-102, Notice of Intention to Plug the No. 2 well.

As I mentioned in our telephone conversation yesterday, after having had a successful casing shut-off test and having drilled only 60 feet of additional hole, the casing parted. Since we were unable to repair the string of casing satisfactorily, we have applied for permission to skid the rig 20 feet to the East to start a new hole, which will be called Well No. 2-A.
