Detailed account of work done, nature and quantity of materials used and results obtained.

This well was drilled to 305' in red bed. Ran 8 jts. (253.77') of 13 3/8" OD 48# 8RD Thd. casing set at 269. Cemented w/300 sacks reg. cement. Cement circulated. Plug was down at 1:30 PM 4-5-58. Cement was allowed to set 24 hours prior to testing for shut-off. Prior to and after drilling plug, 500 pounds pressure was applied with no drop in pressure. Drilling resumed.
