AFFIDAVIT OF RESPONSIBILITY
CONVERSION TO WATER-WELL

1. That he is President of Kincaid & Watson Drilling Company

2. That Kincaid & Watson Drilling is the operator of a well drilled on land be-

longing to J. C. Neafus, whose address is Newkirk, New Mexico
(Landowner)
J. C. Neafus, said well being drilled to test for hydrocarbons and/or carbon dioxide gas and described as the Humble-Moore No. 1-A, being located 620 feet from the North line and 2020 feet from the West line of Section 23, Town-ship 11 North, Range 28 East, NMPM, Guadalupe County, New Mexico.
3. That said well was drilled to a total depth of 1128 feet, and that casing has been set and cemented as follows:

7" at 950 feet with 75 sacks of cement

4. That operator and landowner have made an agreement whereby operator ~~(XX)~~ (is not) to back fill pits, level location, and clear it of all junk. The agreement further provides that operator is to plug said well back to a plugged-back total depth of 945 feet and transfer well to landowner for his use as a water-well. Operator will leave casing in the well as follows:

950 feet of 7"

5. That when operator has complied with the provisions of Paragraph 4 above it will so notify the Oil Conservation Commission of the State of New Mexico on Commission Form C-103, together with a signed statement from the landowner that the provisions of Paragraph 4 above have been complied with to his satisfaction.
