Gentlemen:

Enclosed herewith are your approved copies of the various Commission forms pertaining to your Libby No. 1-X Well, which you drilled in the SW/4 NE/4 of Section 30, Township 20 North, Range 31 East, Harding County, New Mexico, during the past summer.

We would also appreciate receiving, as requested in our letters of June 26 and June 27, 1956, Forms C-102, Notice of Intention to Plug, and C-103, Report of Plugging, for your Libby No. 1 Well, located 13 feet South of the No. 1-X Well, in order that we may close our files on the abandoned hole.

Also please be reminded that Schwartz Carbon Company is delinquent in the filing of Commission Form C-114, Extraction Plant Monthly Report, for the entire time during which you have operated your plant at Hueyeros. We quote our letter of June 26:

"Please fill out and return one copy of the C-114 for each month since you assumed operation of the plant. Rule 1113 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations requires that this monthly report be filed with the Commission on or before the 15th day of the next succeeding month. Please report plant intake and residue in MCF of gas at 15.025 psia and 600°F, and plant production in pounds of dry ice or gallons of liquid CO₂ as the case may be."

Inasmuch as any operator who fails to submit this monthly report subjects his plant operations to the hazard of being suspended by order of the Commission, it behooves the operator to comply with the above-described requirement.

We trust that we may hear from you in the near future.
