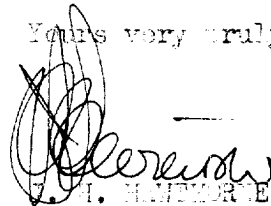
Dear Mr. Utz:

Thank you kindly for your letter of June 1st in connection with the referenced matter and in reply to my letters of March 29th and April 20th. We should appreciate your obtaining the necessary reports on which you can base the information I have requested. The relations of Colo-Mex Gas Company with the former management of Iceco, Inc. were most unsatisfactory, but there has been a considerable improvement in our dealings since a new management of Iceco, Inc. took over shortly after the first of last February. I do not know how recently you have requested the necessary reports from Iceco, but if it has not been within the last three or four months I think you are apt to find them more co-operative.

I do not want to incorrectly report the existence of other wells, but as I stated in my letter of March 29th it is my understanding that Iceco has drilled two wells on property adjoining the DePace well No. 2. I should appreciate your advising me whether there are two other wells, and if so, whether the second well has been drilled in violation of your rules and regulations.

I trust that I may have all of the information I have requested as soon as possible.
