

M-27-16N-33E: From above to wildcat 15 air miles north of Logan. Operator (Astro-Tex) was in rush to get approval prior to 4/1/75 and indicated drilling would begin immediately upon granting of permit by O.C.C. (C-101 was approved 3/17/75). Inspection found large trailer-mounted rig on location, mud pits and cellar dug, but drilling not begun. Two workmen were converting a large van (from tractor-trailer freight rig) into living quarters at well site. From data concerning otherwells in area, and judging by size of drilling rig here, it is estimated proposed well could be at total depth within a week. CU - 4/22/75
