This letter is to inform you that recent field inspections on the subject wells indicate that reclamation of your Hayoz Well No. 2 has yet to be completed and that your No. 1 well needs to have a surface plug and dry hole marker installed unless you have immediate plans on completing this well.

Hayoz Well No. 3 is considered by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division as an abandoned location and no drilling is to be started without new permits.

This letter is our final request that you provide the required forms and site work on these wells. Failure to comply with this request in a timely manner will force the Division to institute legal action.
