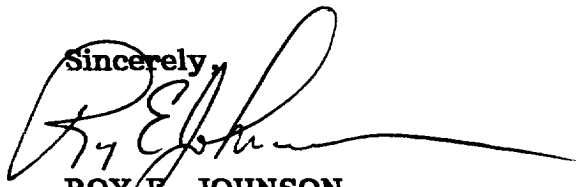
Dear Lefty:

Enclosed please find the approved Sundry Notices for your carbon dioxide wells in Harding County. Please note that this office will require that your Hayoz No. 1 Well be repaired within the next 90 days. Due to the corrosive nature of carbon dioxide, this office's policy requires that high casing annulus pressures must be repaired within 90 days.

In regard to your Garcia Well No. 1 (H-3-20N-30-E), this office has yet to receive the appropriate sundry notice requesting an extension for temporary abandonment status. Please forward this information as soon as possible.
