Dear Jim:

I am attaching Form C-103, Miscellaneous Reports on Wells, in triplicate, covering the plugging of the J. E. Edwards Co.'s #1 Dr. W. A. Maddox well in Section 6, T-18-N, R-25-E, Harding Co., New Mexico. The well is plugged in such manner that a water well may be made from two horizons -- shown on the Schlumberger electric log which is attached hereto.

The Landowner, Dr. W. A. Maddox, requested that the well be left in this condition and he has signed an "Affidavit of Responsibility - Conversion to Water Well" form to that effect and said form is also enclosed in triplicate. Dr. Maddox will shortly forward you direct a signed statement to comply with the provisions in Item 4 of the "Affidavit of Responsibility - Conversion to Water Well".

Thank you very much for your help.

I expect to drill another well in that area in the near future, probably in the bottom of the canyon. The Dr. Maddox #1 Well was the hardest formation I have ever encountered in any drilling operation; we used two 12-1/4" bits and eleven 7-7/8" bits to 1,987'.

The employees of the Mesa Soil Conservation Commission in Roy, N.M., were cleaning up the location, covering the pits, etc. I have instructed them, when the work is completed, to advise you by letter that the job is finished in order that the Plugging Bond may be released.

Again, your help has certainly been appreciated and next time I will be more familiar with New Mexico procedures.
