1. *Chlorophyll a* and *Chlorophyll b* were determined using a spectrophotometer (Shimadzu UV-160U) at 663 nm and 646 nm, respectively. The concentration of chlorophyll was calculated using the following formula: $\text{Chlorophyll } a = 12.7 \times \text{Absorbance at } 663 \text{ nm}$ and $\text{Chlorophyll } b = 22.9 \times \text{Absorbance at } 646 \text{ nm}$. The total chlorophyll concentration was calculated as the sum of chlorophyll *a* and chlorophyll *b*.
