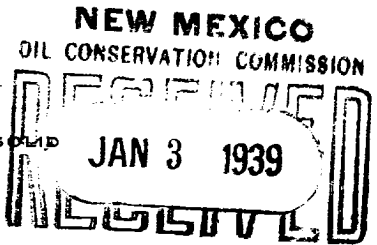

Gentlemen:

Will you please forward to the writer, at P.O.
Box No. 139, Raton, N.M., all official forms necessary to
report completion of our Mitchell No. 2. Well, in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of
SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 20, Twp 19, Range 30 E., Harding County.

This well was completed in ten-inch production string,
set at 1914 feet, and cemented by Halliburton Company with
564 sacks, T.D. 2093 ft., the official completion and acceptance
from contractors being December 31st, 1938.

It is estimated the closed-off pressure will rise
to final pressure of approximately 700 lbs; flow volume
of carbon-dioxide has not yet been officially measured, but
from present indications will probably give settled potential
somewhat in excess of 5,000,000 cu. ft. per day.

We are enclosing a series of photographs of the well
taken during development, which we feel will be of interest
to your department, and which you are at liberty to use in
any way desired.
