Dear Sir:

Enclosed is a schematic drawing which illustrates the condition of the subject well as interpreted from reports which were filed with the Commission. Also enclosed for your information is a copy of the order which calls for plugging this well, together with a copy of the permit issued for drilling same.

Permit me to suggest that you consider travelling to the well site via Highway 87 to about 9 miles northwest of Dalhart, thence west on Highway 102 until you reach Highway 18. About 11 miles south of this intersection, Highway 102 again picks up and continues to Bueyeros village. This route is some 28 miles shorter than going thru Clayton. You should be aware though, that any supplies to be obtained enroute (such as gasoline) would have to be acquired prior to leaving Dalhart. This route puts Bueyeros about 210 miles from Borger, almost the same distance as from Santa Fe.

In accordance with our telephone conversations, I would suggest we meet at a point approximately 1/2 mile west of Bueyeros Village (where Highway 102 curves sharply to the south) at 12:00 noon on Monday, July 18th. If you desire a different arrangement, please advise accordingly. Presumably this visit is for planning your actual work, but if you feel you have enough data to commence plugging operations it will be permissible to do so, although you should file a notice of intent beforehand. The forms for this purpose are enclosed.
