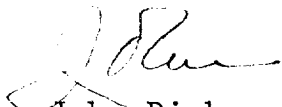
Dear Harvey:

3. 9 feet of 5½ inch pipe (set 6 feet extending above ground level).

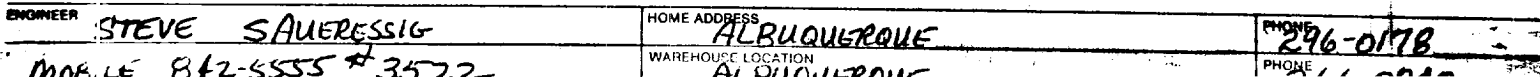

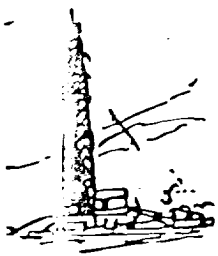
