FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

5 1/2" pipe was set to a T. D. of 1053'. Pipe was perforated from 1018' - 1028'. 1700 gallons of diesel fuel was pumped into formation to break pressure and mud block which still is apparent. Within a week unless the pressure block is eliminated it is planned to shoot the well at perforated section.

The well was plugged back from T. D. to approximately 1030' where a hydromite plug was set to shut off water encountered at approximately 1053', the shut-off having been successful.

There is reason to believe that a commercial producing well may be had when work has been completed although the well is being drilled as a tight hole.

In the event that the well requires shooting with nitro, the Conservation Commission will be notified and permission requested. (Work has been temporarily suspended until rig can be brought in from Oklahoma to complete well.)
