Gentlemen:

Enclosed herewith is your approved copy of our Form C-101, Notice of Intention to Drill.

You will note that we have filled in a proposed casing program inasmuch as this portion of the form had been left blank. Our experience in this area has shown that surface pipe must be set rather deep to protect the fresh-water sands and prevent caving of the hole. Frequently an intermediate string set somewhere in the neighborhood of 1200-1500 feet is also required to case off the Santa Rosa formation. Of course, the size of the hole and the size and weight of the casing remain at your discretion, but you must notify us of any proposed departure from the outlined casing program on our Form C-102.
