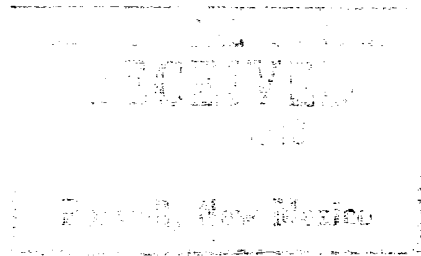
DETAILS OF WORK
