The second water was behind the 10 inch pipe, and there was 300 feet of 10 inch pipe in this well which was pulled and the water that was behind the 10 inch pipe was left to be used for a water well and there was about 400 feet of 8½ on the inside of the 10 inch which we pulled. The 8 inch was filled up about 100 feet with mud, that had filled in by rains.
