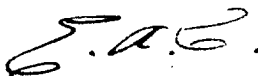

Drilling operations at the above captioned well were resumed August 5th. The hole had bridged approximately 150' off bottom so that it had to be cleaned out. In this process a baler was lost in the hole but was recovered without difficulties.

First cuttings baled out consisted of red shale and sand. Considering the bridging of the hole, these cuttings are not very indicative of the formation at total depth which was previously reported as a quasi-granite wash.

Total depth at 4 P. M. today was 2875' and drilling is continuing. The operator intends to work only during day-light hours.
