- 2080- 90 Porous dolomite as above.
- 2090-2110 White gypsum.
- 2110- 40 Porous dolomite as above.
- 2140- 60 Gray to brown finely crystalline to dense dolomite.
- 2160-2240 Tan to brown finely crystalline, speckled dolomite.
- 2240- 60 Colorless fine grain, subangular limy sandstone, no show.
- 2260- 70 Dolomite as above.
- 2270- 80 Shale as above.
- 2280-2300 Sandstone as above.
- 2300- 90 Red soft, blocky, sandy shale.
- 2390-2400 Colorless very fine grain, hard, tight, limy gypsiferous sandstone, no show.
- 2400- 10 Brown finely crystalline to dense, speckled dolomite, possibly savings.
- 2410- 40 Red shale as above, some salt casts.
- 2440- 70 Red and green soft, blocky shale.
- 2470- 90 Colorless fine to medium grain, limy sandstone, no show, white tripelitic (weathered) chert.
- 2490-2520 Shale as above.
- 2520- 35 Sandstone as above.
- 2535-2720 Shale as above.
- 2720- 30 TOP TUBB (Whitakerse) Brown calcareous dolomite, good porosity, dull to low order fluorescence, no cut. Probable water.
- 2730- 50 Anhydrite as above.
- 2750- 70 Dolomite as above.
- 2770-2810 Brown finely crystalline to dense dolomite.
